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
Nepal: The Context



- Landlocked country (147181 sq km), sharing boundaries with India and China, 3 Ecological region (Mountain, Hills, Terai),
- Federal state: 7 provinces, 77 districts & 753 local level
- Multi cultural and Multi-lingual country with 125 caste groups and 123 languages,
- Literacy rate(2011)= 65.9% (men=75.1, women=57.4%)
- 770,000 children (5-12) OOSC / 22% children out of reach of Early Childhood Development, About 86.8 % of children reach Grade 5 and only three quarters (74.6 %) reach Grade 8. (UNICEF)
- Poverty rate(2011)= 25.2% , Employment rate (2017/18=34% ; 23% women)

- Poor state of traditional livelihood resulting in high migration (Net migration rate (2019)= 2.203 per 1000), High rate of underemployment and seasonal employment, Lack of skills amongst youth,
- National income highly dependent on remittance (about 30% GDP), Growing dependency on foreign aid, Persistent political instability and corruption.
- Population= about 30 million (women 51.5%, men 48.5%), Patriarchal and caste-based society (125 Caste groups): dowry, early marriage, polygamy, son preference, domestic violence, GBV, gender and caste based discrimination in education, health and nutrition and other aspects of life

AEA in Nepal (2009 Onwards) / Présence AEA au Népal depuis 2009


